THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF A5183 (HIGH STREET/ELSTREE HILL NORTH/WATLING STREET), ELSTREE AND A5183 (COBDEN HILL/WATLING STREET), RADLETT) ORDER 2017

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using that length of A5183 (High Street/Elstree Hill North/Watling Street), Elstree and A5183 (Cobden Hill/Watling Street), Radlett from its junction with A411 Watford Road north eastwards and north westwards to its junction with Park Road ("the length of Roads"), a distance of approximately 5110 metres, except for access.

An alternative route will be via A411 (Watford Road/Elstree Road), A41 (Tylers Way/Elton Way), B462 (Hartspring Lane/Radlett Road/Watford Road) and Park Road.

The Order is needed because the deployment of a crane to complete Network Rail and telecoms works are proposed to be executed on or near the length of Roads.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 28 July 2017 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the length of Roads.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
