### THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF LOOM LANE, RADLETT) ORDER 2017

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using that length of Loom Lane, Radlett from its junction with A5183 Watling Street south westwards to its junction with Loom Place ("the Road"), a distance of approximately 369 metres.

An alternative route will be via A5183 Watling Street, Aldenham Avenue, Christchurch Crescent and Loom Place.

The Order is needed because electrical cabling works are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 8 November 2017 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Road.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
