**THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF RADLETT LANE, SHENLEY/
SHENLEY HILL, RADLETT) ORDER 2018**

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using that length of Radlett Lane, Shenley/Shenley Hill, Radlett from its junction with Porters Park Drive south eastwards, south westwards, north westwards and south westwards to its junction with Williams Way ("the length of Roads"), a distance of approximately 2323 metres, except for access.

An alternative route will be via Radlett Lane, B5378 (London Road/Black Lion Hill/Shenleybury), B556 Harper Lane, A5183 Watling Street, Shenley Hill, Newberries Avenue, Craigweil Avenue and Williams Way.

The Order is needed because utility installation works are proposed to be executed on or near the length of Roads.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 15 October 2018 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the length of Roads.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
