Tabard RFC has been supporting Londoners who are significantly affected by coronavirus. The Food Foundation charity estimates that more than three million people in Britain are going hungry because of the pandemic and Tabard, under the leadership of its Chair, Laura-Jo Pearce, has been working literally hand in glove with an initiative called A Plate for London.

#### The Summer Hamper Scheme-Churches Together

The Summer Hamper Scheme, which is now in its fifth year, is currently trying to support local families who are struggling through these difficult times. We have been helping around 20 local families whose children attend St John's and Fair Field Schools. Since circumstances have changed recently, the number of families with children requiring help has risen to 40.

We are supplying families with a weekly hamper containing a mix of non-perishable food and fresh food. Since we can no longer buy in bulk from supermarkets, we have been using local suppliers to help us with the fresh food. We rely on donations from members of

our community.
