

Managers' Report - May 2021

To review the proposed lease for the booster station on top of The Radlett Centre (see minute 191 & 234)

- a) That APC enter into a contract with Russell-Cooke Solicitors to act on behalf of APC in this matter.
- b) That APC enter into a contract with Arc Partners to carry out a survey regarding the potential rent for the mast.
- c) That as this is a new lease, and that APC have now agreed to pay RCT one payment per year, that any rent received remains the income for APC. Chased 4/5 negotiations ongoing.

To receive an update on the Allotment Drive reinstatement project (see minute 196, 232 & 246)

- a) That further discussion takes place regarding the drainage durability of the road Hertsmere Engineering have been asked to update report. 10/5.
- b) That the plans are submitted to Hertsmere Borough Council for consideration.
- c) That the costs of these submissions and the architect's fees are met from the Earmarked Reserves Allotment Project.

Re: Transfer from Barclays to Unity Trust Bank

That APC open an account with Unity Bank PLC with the signatories being any two members of the F&GP Committee. – account open just looking at transferring account – more forms 4/4.

To receive an update from the Phillimore Rec Improvement Project (see minute 241 & 254) That APC appoint Synergy Construction & Property Consultants as cost consultants for the project up to stage four – detailed design, tender, tender analysis and appointment of contractor. – completed, initial costs received 17/5.

Re: —CiL Grant application from Radlett Bowls Club

That a CiL grant of £2,500 is paid to Radlett Bowls Club on production of invoices. - completed.

Re: - Earmarked and Capital reserves allocations for 2021/22. Earmarked Reserves

- (i) Play Equipment -- £19,458 balance OS Committee to be encouraged to investigates ways in which a pathway can be installed to allow access to equipment that avoids the grass as well as renewal/replacement of the 'wet poor' surfaces under some of the older equipment.
- (ii) Increase Earmarked Reserve for 'Trees' to £20,000 to support OS Committee 'Green' agenda of the council to plant more mature trees in place of those removed in Fir Spring Wood and the new hedge alongside the allotment drive.
- (iii) Increase Xmas Lights Earmarked Reserve to £5,000.
- (iv) Election add £2,000 to be carried forward form 20/21 budget, leave a balance of £6,000.
- (v) OS Asset Purchase Earmarked Reserve increase to £30,000.



- (vi) Create new Earmarked Reserve called 'RCT Building Fund' this will include the 'R&M Premises' underspend in 2020/21 budget, the exact amount will be confirmed at the year-end.
- (vii) The "Training "underspend from 20/21 Admin & OS Committees budgets of £1,050 to be added to the IT upgrade Earmarked Reserve' this will cover an initial set up and training fee of IBAS system.

Capital Reserves

- (viii) KGV Development -- reduce to £50,000 -- to be used for resurfacing the access road, possible play equipment in Rose Field and planting in Salters and Picnic Fields.
- (ix) Phillimore Rec Car park -- increase to £131,000 -- to fund the items other that the café.
- (x) Scrubbitts Wood close this fund.
- (xi) Radlett Gardens £23,000.
- (xii) Allotment Project -- £80,542.
- (xiii) Pegmire Lane and Gravel Allotments -- £50,0000.
- (xiv) Gravel Allotments -- £12,500.

Re: RCT/APC common costs

(xv) That APC net the figures owed to it of £21,500 plus the February/March invoices minus £7,117.50 owed to RCT and any other Feb/March invoices and then asks RCT to pay this over the 2021/22 financial year. That APC inform RCT of this arrangement and state that these invoices must be paid by the year end of 2021/22. – arrangement agreed 10/5.
