As you may be aware, next year Her Majesty The Queen will become the first British Monarch to celebrate a Platinum Jubilee, 70 years of service.

Four days of national celebrations are planned – including Trooping the Colour, lighting of beacons Nationwide, Service of Thanksgiving at St Paul's Cathedral, and a Platinum Party at the Palace aired on The BBC.

Aldenham Parish Council are planning two events as part of the celebrations. To kick off the bank holiday weekend, on Thursday 2nd June we will be **lighting a beacon**, as part of the national event, at King George V playing fields. In collaboration with the Rugby Club we will be hosting a fun evening with food, drink and entertainment.

The Radlett Big Jubilee Lunch, Sunday 5th June 2022, is an all-day event Aldenham Parish Council is thrilled to be planning for our entire community to share friendship, food and fun. We are applying to close the main road and put every effort into a stunning display of unity mirroring

We are very keen to involve the children that live in Radlett, Aldenham Green, Letchmore Heath & Round Bush s of our **Jubilee Logo Competition.**

While there is a national logo, we would like a local logo that we can use in all of our advertising, to help promote events happening here in Aldenham. It is open to all Key Stage 2 pupils, and the winner will be publicly announced at the Winter Fair in December, with the winning entrant used on all official publicity. The deadline for returning the submissions in Friday 12th November.

2. Entrants must be in Key Stage 2 and attend school in the parish of Aldenham.

7. The winning entry will be used as the official logo of the Jubilee in Aldenham, with the winner invited to turn on the winter lights at our Winter Fair. By entering you give permission for your entry to be reproduced and displayed publicly in all matters relating to the Jubilee.
8. Closing date for entry is 12th November 2021.
9. The winner will be notified via their school.
