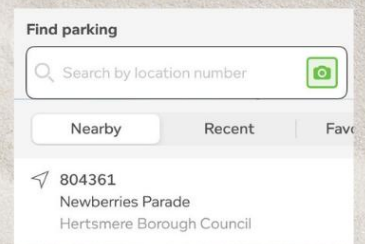
New Food Waste Collection

In April 2025, a new weekly food waste collection will be introduced by Hertsmere Borough Council (HBC). Most residents by now should have received their silver food bin, free roll of liners and instruction leaflet. You can use a kitchen caddy to collect your food waste in the kitchen then transfer this to your silver food waste bin. If you require a free kitchen caddy please come and collect one from our offices, situated at The Radlett Centre.



Newberries Car Park - PayByPhone

Please be aware that when using the app to pay for parking that when you search for location, only Newberries Parade comes up automatically. This is not the car park and will only bring up a charge of 20p which is the administration charge for using the app. Instead, you must type in the location number 79133, which is the car park and the full amount to park there will come up (inc app charge). If the wrong location is selected a fine will be issued. This has been brought to HBC's attention.

ALLOTMENTS AVAILABLE

Allotment gardening is a great way to get outdoors and get active whilst growing your own fruit and vegetables. Aldenham Parish Council own and manage an allotment site on land adjacent to Phillimore Recreation Ground. The allotment season runs from 1st October to 30th September.

We operate a waiting list policy for allotments. Plots are allocated following the order of the date of receipt of the application form in the office and parishioners who do not already have an allotment will take priority over parishioners who already hold a plot.
